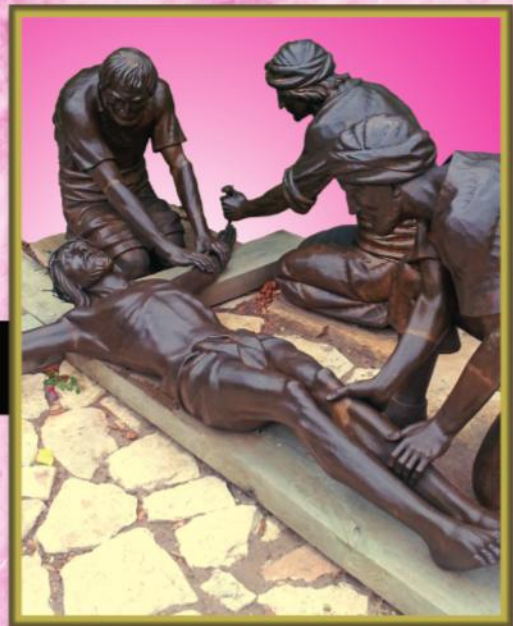

Jesus is stripped of his garments.

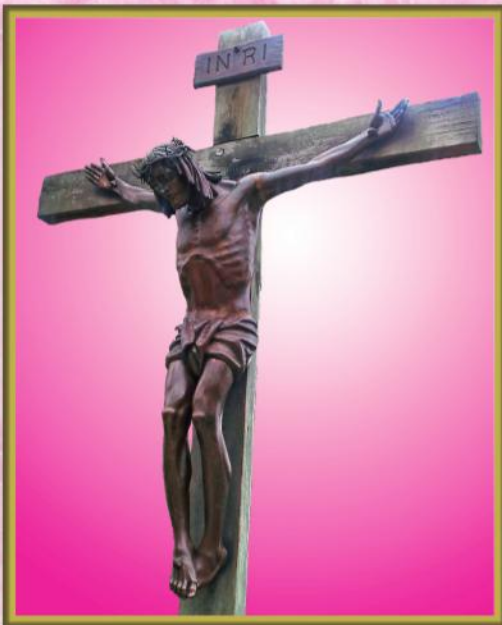
